The Certificate III in Individual Support (Ageing) provides training for working as a carer in a residential aged care facility. Learners will be introduced to all aspects of a carer's role including personal care, wellbeing and assistance with daily activities.

This course is suitable for those who wish to formalise their existing community work skills as well as those who wish to work in aged care.

A nationally recognised certificate will be issued after successful completion of all units.
